Feeding Herbs to Your Horse

Our powdered herbal blends can be fed by mixing with your horse's feed and adding a small amount of water or apple cider vinegar to bind it to the feed.

Alternatively, you can mix the dose with enough water to make about 60ml of tea and administer with a dosing syringe.

Feed herbs for 6 days a week, with one day of rest.

The B-Mare blend is support for mares that experience difficulty during estrus. It contains herbs with properties known to help even out hormonal fluctuations and to help with pain and discomfort.



B-Mare contains the following herbs (materia medica):

- Raspberry Leaves:** astringent, tonic, spasmolytic, vulnerary, hemostatic, parturient
- Wild Lettuce:** anodyne, sedative, hypnotic
- Cramp Bark:** spasmolytic, emmenagogue, sedative, astringent
- Black Cohosh:** anti-inflammatory, spasmolytic, nervine, emmenagogue, alterative, diaphoretic
- Dandelion:** hepatic, alterative, cholagogue, aperient, tonic
- Vervain:** emmenagogue, astringent, antispasmodic, diaphoretic, alterative, galactagogue, cholagogue

Definitions:

- alterative - tending to alter favorably the course of an ailment
- anodyne - relieves distress or pain
- anti-inflammatory - reduces inflammation
- antispasmodic - suppresses muscle spasms
- aperient - relieves constipation
- astringent - causes contraction of body tissues
- cholagogue - promotes discharge of bile
- diaphoretic - warming, increases perspiration
- emmenagogue - stimulates or increases menstrual flow
- galactagogue - promotes lactation
- hemostatic - causes bleeding to stop
- hepatic - strengthens or supports liver function
- nervine - calms the nerves, benefits the nervous system
- parturient - promotes or eases childbirth
- sedative - promotes calm
- spasmolytic - relieves spasm of smooth muscle
- tonic - substance that produces vigor or well-being
- vulnerary - of use in the healing of wounds
