Feeding Herbs to Your Horse

Our powdered herbal blends can be fed by mixing with your horse's feed and adding a small amount of water or apple cider vinegar to bind it to the feed.

Alternatively, you can mix the dose with enough water to make about 60ml of tea and administer with a dosing syringe.

Feed herbs for 6 days a week, with one day of rest.

Navikare is an herbal blend that supports the bones, joints, and connecting tissues of the hoof. Navikare is support for horses with navicular issues.



Navikare contains the following herbs (materia medica):

Boswellia: anti-inflammatory, anti-rheumatic, diaphoretic, analgesic

Yarrow: diaphoretic, analgesic, vasodilator, hemostatic, astringent, antispasmodic

Devil's Claw: anti-inflammatory, anti-rheumatic, analgesic

Turmeric: alterative, anti-inflammatory, hepatoprotective, antioxidant, antiplatelet, analgesic, astringent, antiseptic

Hawthorn: cardiotonic, hypotensive, astringent

Meadowsweet: anti-inflammatory, astringent, anti-rheumatic, analgesic, diaphoretic, antispasmodic

Definitions:

- alterative - tending to alter favorably the course of an ailment
- analgesic - pain relief
- anti-inflammatory - reduces inflammation
- antioxidant - prevents oxidation of molecules - protects against cell damage
- antiplatelet - prevents blood clots
- anti-rheumatic - reduction of pain and inflammation in joints, muscles, and fibrous tissue
- antiseptic - prevents the growth of disease causing microorganisms
- antispasmodic - suppresses muscle spasms
- astringent - causes contraction of body tissues
- cardiotonic - supports heart function - helps circulation
- diaphoretic - warming, increases perspiration
- hemostatic - causes bleeding to stop
- hepatoprotective - prevents damage to liver
- hypotensive - lowers tension
- vasodilator - widens or dilates blood vessels
